



**Scott City High School**  
**A+ Probationary Guidelines**  
 Revised March 28, 2012



(Addendum 1) If approved by the A+ Advisory Committee, an offending student may be put on probation for the remainder of his/her high school career **AND** must adhere to the probationary guidelines set forth by the A+ Advisory Committee. Probationary guidelines are as follows: 1) Create an educational presentation to present to elementary or middle school students, 2) Complete twenty hours of community service that will take place on school grounds, and 3) Write a personal reflection to be presented to the A+ Advisory Committee. Students placed on probation will be provided a timeline to complete the requirements from the A+ Committee. Upon final approval that all probationary criteria have been satisfied, the student will be taken off probation the day he/she graduates.

*Any violation of the Citizenship Guidelines while on probation will result in an automatic dismissal from the A+ Schools Program.*

**Requirement 1)** Present an educational presentation to elementary or middle school students. This presentation must be approved and scheduled by the A+ Coordinator.

**Requirement 2)** Twenty hours of community service that will take place on school grounds. Hours must be supervised by a faculty/staff member of the district and approved by the A+ Coordinator. Hours must be completed prior to presenting your Personal Reflection to the A+ Advisory Committee.

**Requirement 3)** Following completion of probationary requirements 1 and 2 you will present your case in the format of a personal reflection. This reflection will focus on your learning experiences and personal growth persuading the A+ Advisory Committee that you are indeed a good citizen of Scott City High School and possess the individual discipline and responsibility that is representative of such. The A+ Advisory Committee will then review the probationary terms and approve or decline that you have satisfactorily completed all the probationary requirements and can be eligible for the A+ scholarship. Reflection presentations will be scheduled by the A+ Coordinator and will occur by April 1 of your graduating year. You will be taken off probation the day you graduate.
